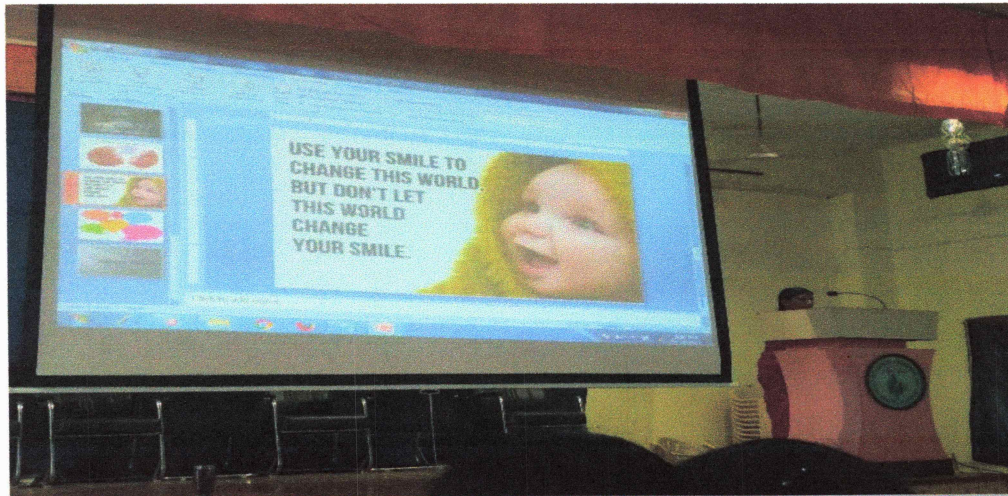
GENDER EQUALITY AND REALIZING EQUAL RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES
