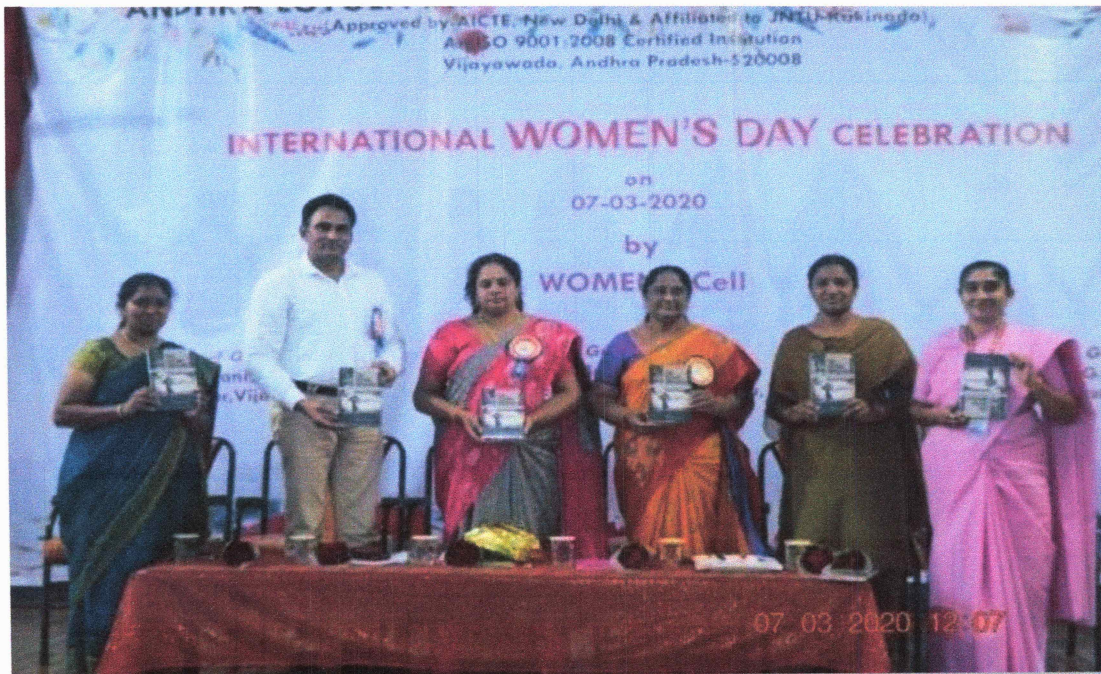
I AM GENERATION EQUALITY: REALIZING WOMEN'S RIGHTS

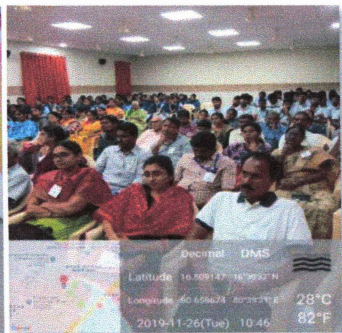
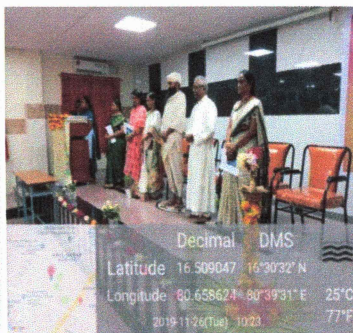
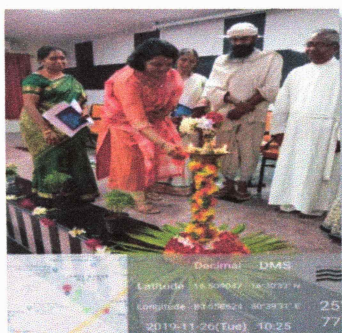
